

COURSE OF STUDY

Primary Department

First Year

Reading — Lessons from chart and blackboard both print and script.
Combined methods.

Numbers — Digital numbers from 1 to 10 and all combinations of same,
as per Superintendent's syllabus.

Writing — Forming of simple letters and then their combinations.

Language — Oral instruction as to words and short sentences, capitals,
periods, and interrogation points.

Second Year

Reading — First Reader.

Numbers — Addition and subtraction of numbers to 50. U. S. coins and
Federal money. Illustrate use of $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, etc. Roman numerals to L.

Writing — Pen and ink. Small and capital letters. Copying parts of
the reading lesson.

Language — Oral. Relating to object lessons. Systematic drill to
correct colloquial errors. Learn short poems.
